The application for the Designated Subject Certificate shall be recommended by the conference office of education for consideration by the union conference officer and/or Certification Review Committee.

## THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET:

- 1. Eligibility requirements as outlined in the North American Division K-12 Educators' K-12 Certification Manual.
- 2. The initial General Eligibility Requirements (see Section 1.4 except 1.4.3 and 1.4.4.
- 2. Possesses a high school diploma or has passed an equivalency examination as designated by the union office of education or in the case of an applicant for a Designated Administrator Certificate, a baccalaureate degree (see Section 2.6).
- 3. Verification of successful and recent experience in the technical skill, trade vocation, or non-vocational subject named on the certificate with a minimum equivalent of five years of experience. One year of the required experience must be within the three-year period immediately preceding the application for issuance of the certificate. Work experience is defined as paid work experience or its equivalent.
